



Why is Jami truly distributed?

We keep saying that Jami's most distinctive and innovative characteristic is the fact that it doesn't require a server to relay data between users. There are many advantages associated with that, including increased privacy, light infrastructure, high scalability, no bandwidth restriction (other than that of your Internet connection), no size limit for file transfers, and more. This is all true, but while servers are not required, they are still used in five specific cases: push notifications, the OpenDHT proxy, bootstrap, name server, and TURN.

The first three cases where a server can be used for Jami are all related to OpenDHT, the technology allowing Jami devices to find each other on the Internet without a server. Computers use IP addresses to communicate with each other online, but it is usually dynamic and therefore changes over time. OpenDHT provides a way to identify devices on the network with a unique ID and to retrieve their IP address without
